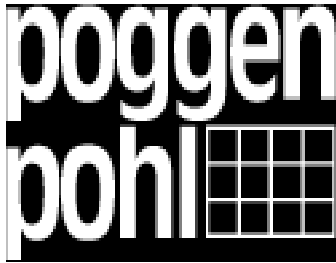


It Takes a Village of Experts to Build a "Home for a Lifetime"
